EDUCATION PROGRAM-ACLAB

Alliance for Cooperation & Legal Aid Bangladesh-ACLAB Bhasanchar, Hatiya, Noakhali



BACKGROUND: The education program of ACLAB is a humanitarian intervention that aims to ensure the provision of quality education for the children, and adolescents of the Forcefully Displaced Myanmar Nationals (FDMN) community living in Bhasanchar, Hatiya, Noakhali district. Bhasanchar is an island in the Bay of Bengal where 32K Rohingya community people are living in the Asrayan project of Bangladesh Government. In collaboration with the RRRC office, CiC office, UNHCR, BRAC, UNICEF, Education Sector, and other NGOs and INGOs, the ACLAB Bhasan Char education program started on January 31, 2021. The project recognizes the right to education



for all and strives to provide equitable and quality life skills and education to the FDMN people, using the Myanmar curriculum.

EDUCATION PROJECT: ACLAB has been providing the quality education for FDMN children for more than 3 years in Bhasanchar and currently also implementing the BRAC Pooled fund education project supported by GAC. The project titled "Provision of quality education for Rohingya Refugees living in Bhasan Char". Under the program ACLAB is operating 3 schools with a number of 17 classes in 6 clusters. In both morning and day shifts, among 1144 students, 602 students are girls and 542 are boys are studying Myanmar Curriculum in ECD (Early Childhood Development), KG, Grade (G)-1, 2, 3, 4, and 6. 19 teachers (5 female and 14 male) are teaching English, Math, Science, Social Science and Burmese Language curriculum in the classes. In Bhasanchar for the FDMN children ACLAB has introduced child-friendly spaces for their early childhood development and extracurricular activities like outdoor & indoor games, cultural programs & play-based learning besides regular study. There are girls' and boys' adolescent clubs for the age group 13 to 18 who are receiving different life skill education like basic literacy, and numeracy, under these initiatives.

To ensure quality and equitable education, ACLAB regularly conducts meetings with parents, community members, community leaders, and the School Management Committee (SMC) to promote education, particularly for girls. ACLAB focuses on the priority of girl's education besides the child with a disability (CWD).
